Subject: Results of Deer Hill Road and St. Mary's Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project Bid

Introduction / Discussion

The City was awarded federal stimulus funding for this project. The City Council previously approved a staff request to delegate award authority for this project to the City Manager in an amount not to exceed the funding allocated to the project of \$744,000.

Bids were publicly opened by the City Clerk on July 8. The City received six bids for this project. The low bid is \$663,091.05, 2.5% lower than the engineer's estimate, and nearly all bids are within 10% of the lowest bidder. The bid results are listed below:

Since the bids received are within the funding allocated, the City Manager awarded the contract to the low bidder, MCK Services, on July 17.
