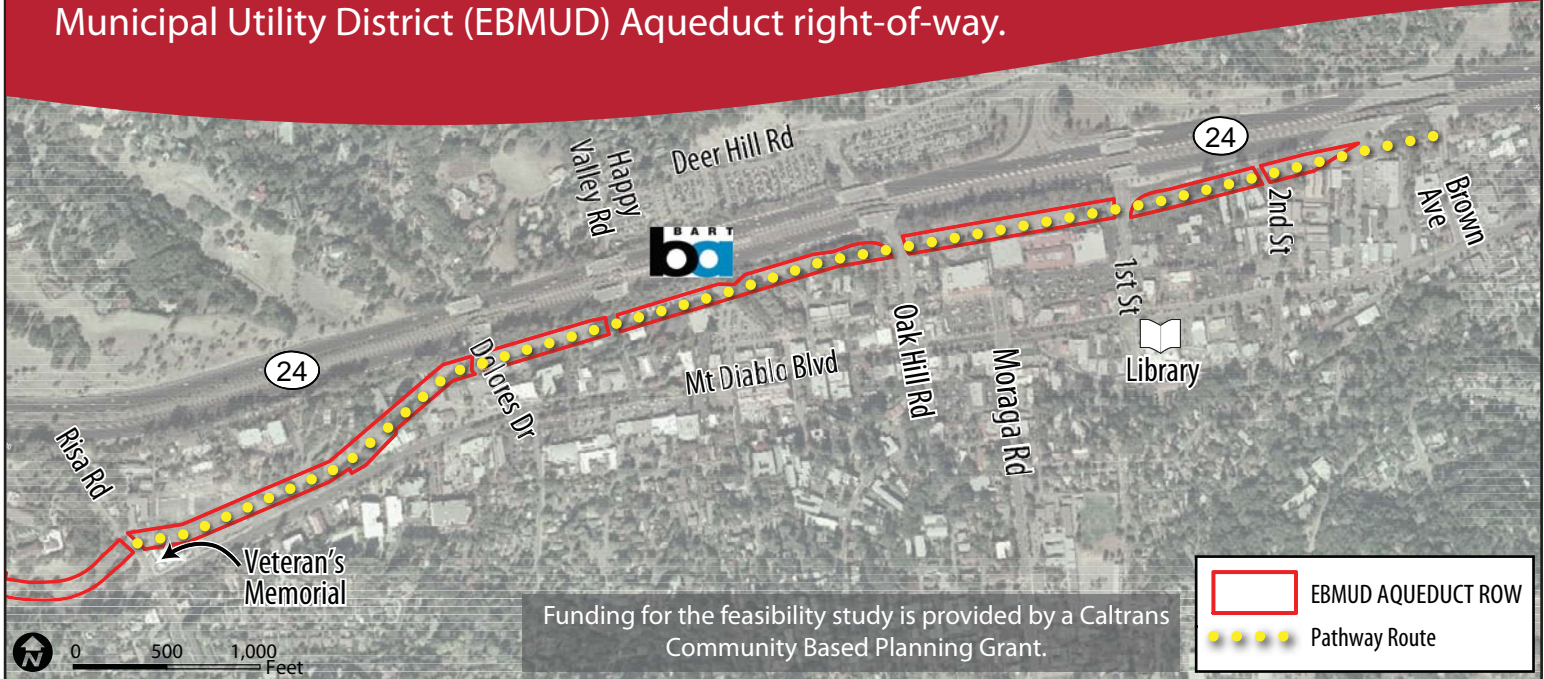


The City of Lafayette invites interested community members to participate in **public presentations to City Commissions and Committees** of the City's Feasibility and Options Study of a Bicycle and Pedestrian Pathway along the East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) Aqueduct right-of-way.



About the study: The pathway under study would follow the EBMUD Aqueduct through Downtown Lafayette from Risa Road to Brown Avenue, south of State Route 24 and north of Mount Diablo Boulevard. The draft study evaluates various options and presents a preferred option and phasing plan.

About the meetings: These public presentations before the City's Commissions and Committees provide an opportunity for the City's various review bodies to familiarize themselves with the draft study and ask questions. Members of the public are encouraged to attend. The same material will be presented at both meetings.
